# Working with Surrey Care Association Ltd



### About us

SCA are a not for profit organisation, established for 8 years. We represent Adult Social Care (and recently extended to include Health) providers in the county of Surrey and neighbouring areas. We represent care and nursing homes for older people, care homes and supported living for Adults with Disabilities (Physical and Learning Disabilities and other specialist needs eg Autism), Domiciliary Care, Extra Care/Assisted Living and Housing Support and Day Services.

Surrey has around 800 care service locations – some of our providers are larger national care groups, smaller independent groups, and a high number of independent companies including charitable, not for profit and voluntary. We are fortunate that many of our services are not dependent on public funding – one of the reasons Surrey has proved a popular location for businesses to invest. Some services are dependent on public funding from local authority or health in the Disability sector but they are focussed on developing quality, innovative services. From May 2014 we became a paid subscriber organisation having for a number of years received very significant funding from Surrey County Council. This independence has enabled us to develop positive relationships with suppliers to the Care industry.

Our key services and benefits to our subscribers we also communicate with all services through a weekly non subscriber bulletin. Non subscribers also participate in our events and conferences at a higher cost and we continually encourage them to Subscribe.

# What we can offer suppliers

#### **Commercial Partners**

This is our major category. This commercial partnership will benefit both companies – for a company to raise their profile and extend the opportunities for new business through the SCA network of care providers. By working together we expect a company's profile to be raised through our partnership and ongoing relationship.

Partners agree to sponsor SCA in return for a range of individually negotiated benefits reflecting their objectives. This is typically £2000 to £3000 a year. The benefits can include

- The provision of a free stand at SCA conferences in October and May

### **Commercial Subscribers**
